

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
FOR THE CITY OF WHITE WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT**

The City of White is proposing to replace water distribution mains and rehabilitate the existing water tower. The City of White is seeking up to \$6,000,000 for the water mains replacement and water tower rehabilitation from the Board of Water and Natural Resources. The project may be completed in phases. The funds could be either grants from the State Consolidated Water Facilities Construction Program or a loan from the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) program. The expected DWSRF loan terms are 2.125 percent for up to 30 years. The Board of Water and Natural Resources may forgive all or a portion of the loan principal. The amount and source of funds will be determined by the Board of Water and Natural Resources when the application is presented at a scheduled board meeting.

The purpose of the public hearing is to discuss the proposed project, the proposed financing, the source of repayment for the loan and to receive comments regarding the application from members of the community. The meeting is open to the public and interested persons are encouraged to attend.

Notice is further given to persons with disabilities that this hearing is being held at a physically accessible place. The TTY/TDD number is 1-800-877-1113 or 711.
