

The White City Council met Monday, December 4, 2017 at 7:00 pm at the McKnight Community Hall. City Council members present were Kelm, Hopfinger, Wilts, Westberg and Mayor Wright. All motion was unanimous unless otherwise noted. Motion by Westberg seconded by Kelm to approve the minutes. Motion by Hopfinger seconded by Kelm to increase the fee of dog registration to \$5.00 per dog. Motion by Kelm seconded by Westberg to allow the American Legion to hang the bingo boards as long as the covering for them is approved by the council. Motion by Kelm seconded by Westberg to have the Tri-City Star as the official newspaper for 2018. Motion by Hopfinger seconded by Wilts to approve First Bank & Trust, White as the official bank for 2018. Motion by Motion by Kelm seconded by Wilts to approve Jesse Ronning as the city attorney for 2018. Motion by Westberg seconded by Hopfinger to move January meeting to January 3, 2018 at 7:00 pm. Motion by Wilts seconded by Hopfinger to disconnect all overdue account if not paid within 2 weeks, Cutler obtained.

Motion by Wilts seconded by Hopfinger to go in to executive session at 10:12 pm, council came out of executive session at 11:11 pm.

Motion by Westberg seconded by Kelm to approve the following wages for 2018, Daniel DeYoung, Maintenance Superintendent \$40,492.10, Mary Raine, Finance Officer \$20.60 per hour. Tracey Cook and Kelli Westberg as hall cleaners at \$15.00 per hour, Tracy Haaseth, Park and Rec moving \$14.00 per hour. All other part time employees hired by the city, will start between minimum wage to \$15.00 per hour depending on jobs and qualifications. Council people will be \$100.00 per regular meeting, \$30.00 per special meeting. Mayor will be per regular meeting \$160.00 and special meetings at \$30.00 per meeting.
