Public hearing for the City of White Water System Improvements Project. Project is proposed to be done in two phases with a beginning date in 2022. Greg Maag with First District reviewed the application process and funding. The application for funding is in process is January 1, 2022. A funding package would be presented in March 2022. The City of White would be seeking up to \$5,000,000 for water mains replacement and water tower rehabilitation.
