The White City Council held its meeting Friday, March 9, 2018 at 6:00 pm at the McKnight Community Hall. City council members present were Hopfinger, Cutler, Westberg, Kelm and Mayor Wright. All motions were unanimous unless otherwise noted. Motion by Hopfinger seconded by Kelm to approve the minutes of the meeting.

Council came out of executive session at 8:41 pm.

Motion by Hopfinger seconded by Kelm to approve a Health Reimbursement for each fulltime employee, all employees treated as singles up to \$250.00 per month. Motion by Kelm seconded by Hopfinger to increase the electric rates by 3% and add a surcharge of \$5.00 per household or apartment. Motion by Kelm seconded by Westberg to adjourn at 8:49 pm.
