WHEREAS it is the desire of the City of **White** to construct the pedestrian route within the community; and

WHEREAS the proposed project will comply with all planning and zoning regulations: and

WHEREAS the City of **White** agrees to provide the necessary local match for the proposed project: and

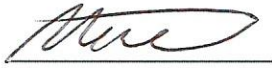
WHEREAS the City of **White** will secure the required right-of-way for the construction of the project; and

WHEREAS the City of **White** agrees to maintain the pedestrian route, if funded, for its useful life.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the White City Council duly approves the submission of a SD DOT Transportation Alternatives Program Grant application requesting \$596,018.79 of funding for the eligible costs for the proposed project.

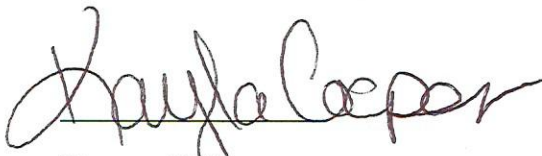
